Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Byram Township Board of Education has a policy regarding making up snow days. Policy #6114 states "If school is closed due to weather or other emergencies between the opening day and January 31st, those days will be made up during the winter recess, excluding Presidents day which is a legal holiday". Since school was closed early in the season on October 31st and November 1st for inclement weather, the Byram Township Board of Education has rescinded the school closing on Martin Luther King Day and approved that January 16, 2012 be an early dismissal day for students and in the afternoon an in-service day for staff members.

As of today, only one day of the winter recess will be taken away and that date is Wednesday, February 22nd. Please remember that if another inclement weather day is used prior to January 31st we will lose the Tuesday of the winter recess.

I trust that this early advisement will allow you sufficient time to make the necessary adjustments in your family schedule.
