**This clinic will offer only 2009 H1N1 injectable vaccine.**  
As recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the following target populations will be eligible to receive the vaccine at this clinic:

- Pregnant women
- Household contacts and caregivers for children younger than 6 months of age
- Healthcare and emergency medical services personnel
- All people from 6 months through 24 years of age
- Persons aged 25 through 64 years who have health conditions associated with higher risk medical complications from influenza.
