- Write resumes and interview for jobs.

The Babysitter's Training course has a unique interactive, educational format that tasks youth, ages 11 - 15 years of age, with activities such as identifying safety problems around the house and yard and selecting age-appropriate toys and games for children in their care. Participants learn by doing. This format, along with the course video and an enthusiastic instructor, keeps the interest of the babysitters and provides a meaningful classroom experience!

The fee for this course is \$65 and includes all course materials, supplies and a certification card. The classes for the fall are **September 11th** from 9 to 3:30; **October 2nd** from 9 to 3:30, **Nov 4th & 5th** from 1 – 4:30 and **December 29** from 9 to 3:30.
